WHOOOO'S EXCITED FOR OWL WEEK? NOVEMBER 6TH - NOVEMBER 10TH

Monday, November 6th: Classroom introduction to Owl Week

Tuesday, November 7th: Visitors from the Indiana Audubon Society will present on saw-whet owls and the banding process.

Wednesday, November 8th: Dress Down to Adopt an Owl! Money raised for dress down day will go towards adopting an owl. \$25 adopts 1 owl. This year, classrooms who adopt 3 or more owls will receive a gift of the Project OwlNet Tote Bag for the teacher.

Students and staff may do one or all of the following to collect money for their class or department:


- Dress as a night owl and wear PJs (\$1)
- Bring a stuffed owl or other stuffed animal (\$1 per animal, up to 2)
- Wear 'owl' themed fashion eyewear or an owl themed hat (\$1)

Thursday, November 9th: Visitors from Humane Indiana Wildlife will bring live owls in and give an associated presentation to students.

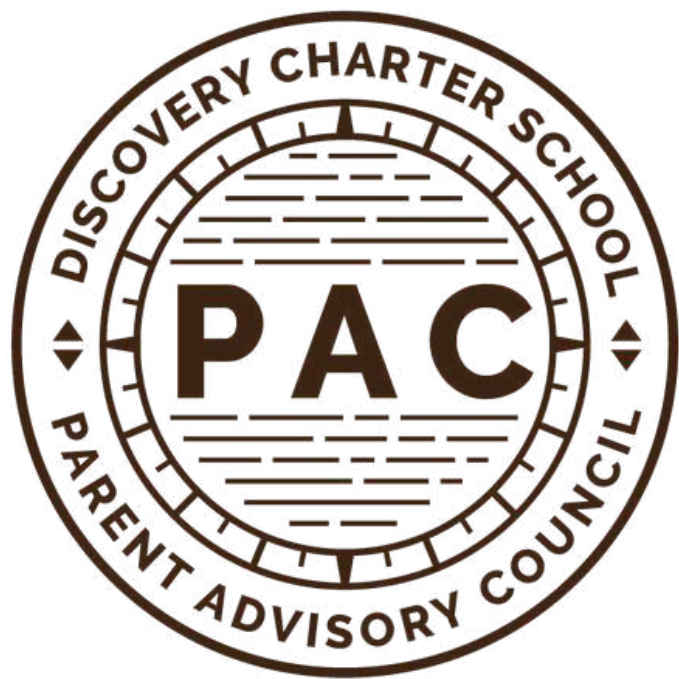
Submission Details:
