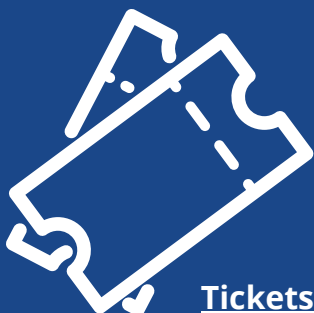

- Each entry should be done by a currently enrolled Discovery Student.

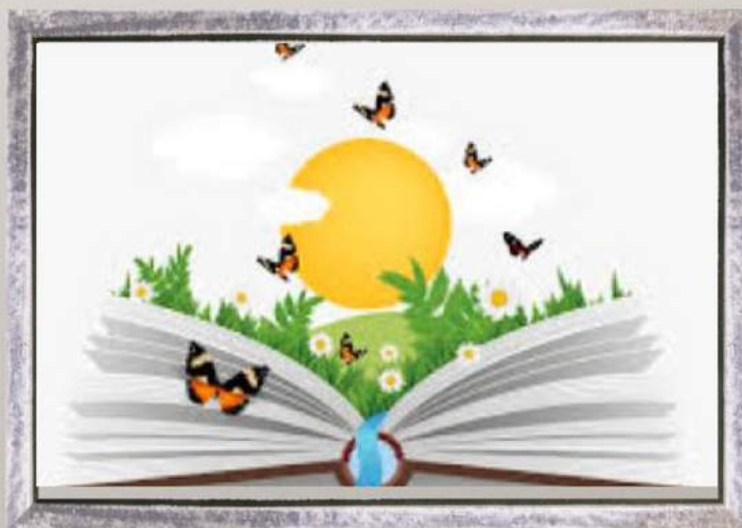
