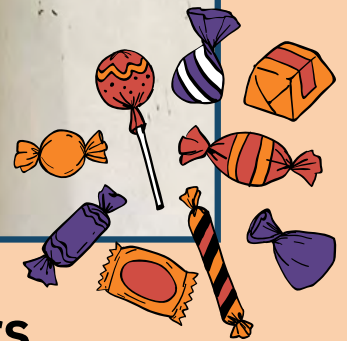

SANDHILL CRANE MIGRATION

WITH MS. GOLBA - DISCOVERY NATURALIST

When: Wednesday, November 16th. We will meet at school at 2:15pm and return to school by 6:00pm.

Where: We will begin at Discovery Charter School where Ms. Golba will give an introduction to the sandhill crane migration and what to expect when we get there. We will then travel by car to Jasper-Pulaski Fish and Wildlife Area to view the cranes at the observation tower. Travel time from Discovery to Jasper-Pulaski is approximately 1 hour.

Dress for the weather - it always feels chillier on the observation tower! Warm layers, hats, and gloves are recommended. Please feel free to bring binoculars and cameras. I will have a supply of binoculars for families to use upon our arrival.

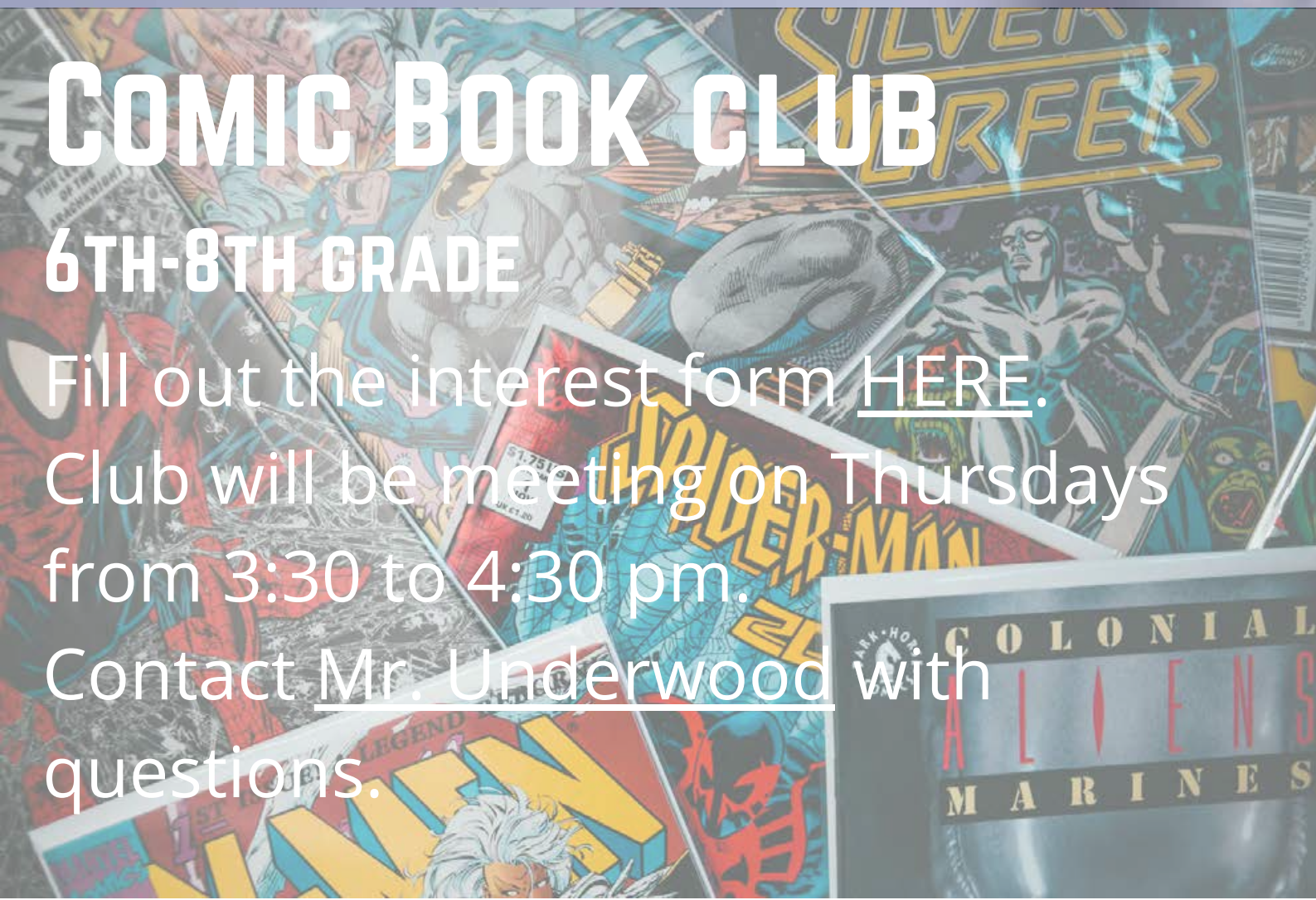

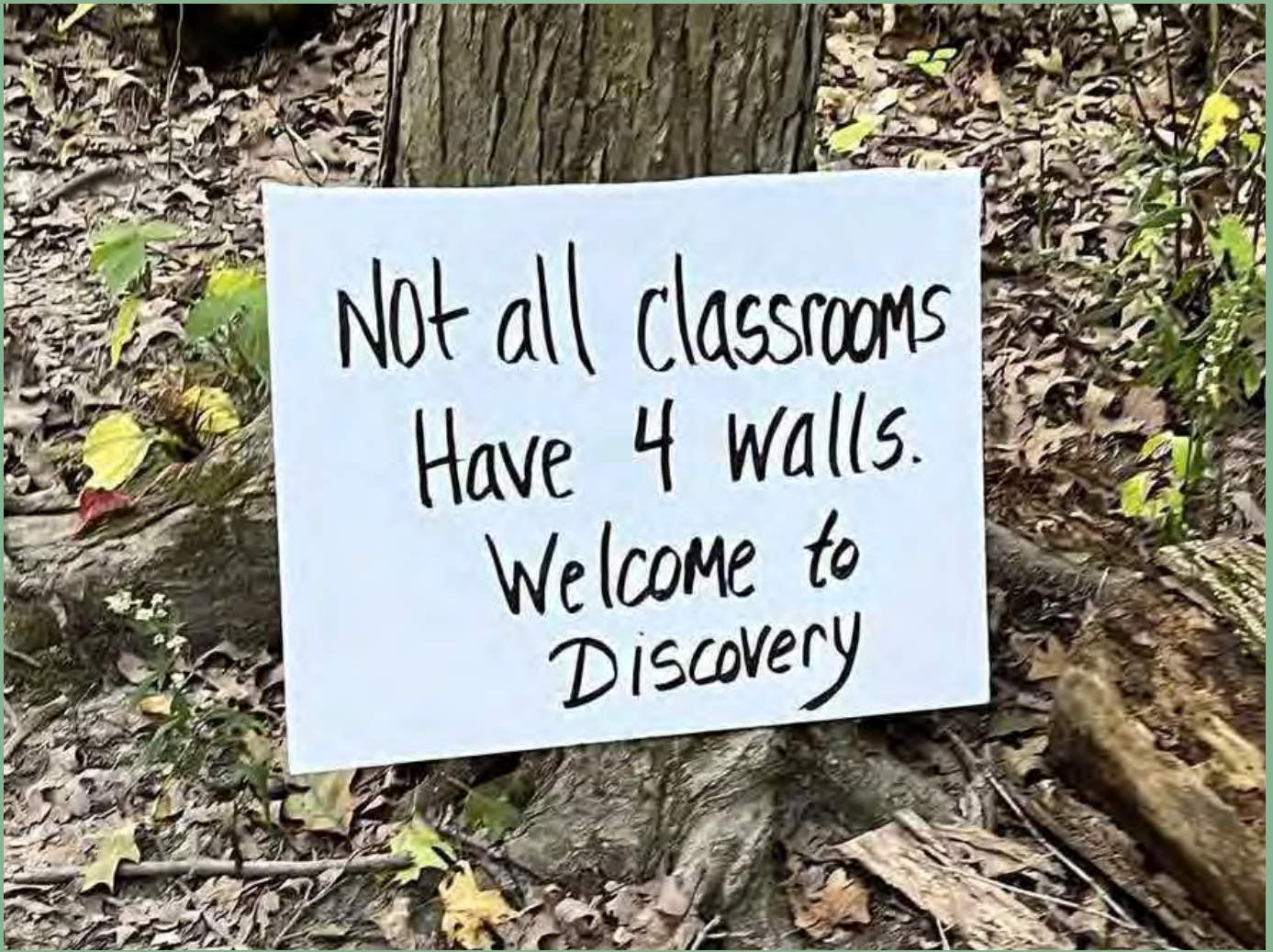
