SCRIP

Have you signed up for SCRIP yet? Are you using it? If you have and haven't signed up for Presto Pay, it is the easiest way to utilize SCRIP. No more trying to think of what you need in advance, you can be at the store and figure out approximately how much you are going to spend, buy SCRIP now and use it with in a few minutes. It is convenient AND sustainable! WIN WIN.

SCRIP volunteers are also available every morning in the lobby from 745-810. You can also send in an order form and cash/check (payable to Discovery PAC) and your order will be filled with in 1-2 business days if we have it in stock, and sent home with the child you put on the form. If it is not in stock we typically order on Tuesdays and have orders out by Friday of the same week.

SCRIP is available for just about everything you can think of from hotels, car rentals (think Fall Break) to restaurants from Cheesecake Factory to WildFire, Walmart, Target, Lands End, Wendy's, Whole Foods, Green House Wives, Lemon Tree, Bartlett's and so, so much more. So next time you shop, you can also be supporting the school.

How far does a little bit go? This year SCRIP funds will be used to purchase bleachers and a scoreboard for the gym so we can have home games!! So it goes a LONG way.
