Stage Crew

To be a part of a stage crew, you must be familiar with the entire show. You will need to know when set pieces are to come on and off, where all the props belong and who uses them. Crews need to work quietly, swiftly, problem solve and have good communication.

We are limited to 12 crew members, however there may be additional opportunities to assist such as seating guests, passing out programs and co-ordinating costumes.

Beginning in February, you will be required to attend all rehearsals. Tuesdays 4-5:30, Weds 2-4, and a possible Saturday. Be prepared to watch rehearsals, follow along in the script and take notes for scene changes. This is not a time to socialize.

The week of the show is called Tech Week. This is a very important week for crew. You will need to attend Mon-Sat. We will be setting up the stage and costumes, checking sound and lighting, and rehearsing the show. Each night we will have to clean up and reset for the next day. You will have to be motivated and take instruction from the stage managers.

Crew positions are open to students 4th-8th. The cost is \$30. If you feel you are able to fulfill this role, please fill out an application. Submit to the office, in an envelope labeled STAGE CREW APPLICATION by Friday January 18th. You will be notified via email by Sunday, Jan 20th if you are chosen to work with the crew this year. There will be a required crew meeting on Tuesday, January 22nd from 3:45-4pm. The \$30 fee will be due at your first rehearsal in February.
